NOTICE OF RACE

1. DATES & VENUE

Racing will take place on 13th and 14th November 2010 on the Knysna lagoon and will begin and end at the Knysna Yacht Club or Committee boat. The Regatta Headquarters will be the Knysna Yacht Club.

2. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2009-2012, The Equipment Rules of Sailing (ERS) 2009 – 2012, the applicable Class Rules, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1. Competitors shall comply with the International Sailing Federation (ISAF) eligibility requirement in accordance with RRS Part 6. All competitors (skipper and crew) shall be members in good standing of a Yacht Club affiliated to and in good standing with SA Sailing. Their Club name and membership details shall be stated on the entry form.

3.2. The regatta is open to all dinghy classes, catamarans and small keelboats. The official SASEC boat handicap system, as amended for Estuary conditions, based on Portsmouth Ratings that shall be displayed on the Regatta Notice Board will apply.

3.3. Eligible boats may be entered by completing the attached entry form and sending it, together with the entry fee by **15h00 on 12th November 2010 to:**

3.4. Late entries will be accepted up to 1 hour before the scheduled start of the any race.

3.5 There is an early bird discount for entering before 15h00 on 5 November 2010.

4. CLASSIFICATION

4.1. The Sailor Classification Code as described in ISAF Regulation 22 shall apply.

5. ENTRY FEES

5.1. There is an early bird discount for entering before 17h00 on 5 November 2010.

The required entrance fees are as follows:

- Single Handed per boat: R140.00 (**early bird R100**)
- Double Handed per boat R200.00 (**early bird R150**)
- Single Handed Juniors per boat R50.00 (Under 18) (**early bird R30**)
- Double Handed Juniors per boat R60.00 (Under 18) (**early bird R40**).

5.3 Late entry fee is R50.

6. SCHEDULE

6.1 Entries shall be confirmed by registration with the Regatta Secretary at the venue from 09h00 on Saturday 13th November 2010 until 10h30.

6.2 A voluntary briefing is scheduled to take place after 11h00 on Saturday 13th November .

6.3 The first race is scheduled to start at 12h00 on Saturday 13th November 2010. The times for subsequent races will be advised.

6.4 Six races are scheduled, to a maximum of 8 if conditions allow. A minimum of three races is required for a regatta. No warning signal will be made after 15h00 on Sunday 14th November 2010.

7. MEASUREMENTS

In terms of the Class rules each boat should have a valid registration/ measurement certificate. Boats without measurement certificates may be subject to random measurement.

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available from the Regatta Secretary on completion of registration formalities.

9. THE COURSES

Maps of the estuary will be available with the sailing instructions. Courses will be designed around the configuration of the Estuary. Courses will be placed on the Regatta Notice Board. The start and finish lines will preferably be off the Knysna Yacht club if conditions allow.

10. PENALTY SYSTEM

For all dinghy classes RRS 44.1 and 44.2 shall apply. For catamarans and small keelboats the penalty shall be a 360 degree tack and gybe.

11. SCORING

11.1 The Low Point System of Appendix A 4.1 will apply.

11.1.1 Team scoring will be done by means of the Sailwave team scoring facility with the number of boats per team being decided dependent on club entries. Keelboats shall not count towards the traditional InterClub or Individual helmman trophies, though separate trophies will be available for the individual keelboat. If at least three keelboats per club from at least two Clubs, a separate keelboat team trophy shall be presented.

11.2 There will be senior and junior fleets, which may be split into sub-categories.

11.3 All Dabchicks and Mirrors will sail in the junior fleet.

11.3 There will be no discards.

12. SAFETY

Yachts shall comply with their class buoyancy and safety requirements. All competitors (excl. keelboats) shall wear a personal buoyancy aid capable of supporting a 5Kg. steel weight at all times while afloat in a yacht.

13. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Unless an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. Keelboats may however make calls for non-racing reasons. Any emergency calls shall be brought to the attention of the Sailing Committee for approval or disqualification.

14. PRIZES

Floating trophies and other prizes will be presented at the Prize Giving which will follow as soon as possible after the last race.

15. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. Neither the Organising Authority nor its officials or other persons associated with the organisation of the event will accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
